

Dear Varicella Surveillance Partners,

There were **17** cases and **3** Outbreak of Varicella reported during the month of March 2010.

A total of **552** WV public schools (elementary, middle/ junior, high school) out of the **696 (79%)** have completed the February varicella survey. A total of **222** school nurses have completed the survey.

Twenty-Nine (29) Counties reported data for 100% of their total schools
